Important Dates

All students <u>must attend</u> an orientation session to prepare for the new procedures and the new year. It will be combined with locker selection.

- <u>Returning Student Orientation and Locker Selection</u>
 - Grade 12, Monday, August 24, 9:00 AM
 - Grade 11, Monday, August 24, 10:00AM
 - Grade 10, Monday, August 24, 11:00 AM
 - Grade 9: At freshman orientation based on your scheduled session.
- First Day of Classes
 - Grades 9, and 10 students will attend classes on Tuesday, September 1.
 - Grades 11, and 12 students will attend classes on Wednesday, September 2.
 - <u>There will be **no classes on Thursday, September 3** so that faculty members can review and adapt to the initial two days of classes.</u>
 - Friday, September 4, is a regularly scheduled day off.

All grade levels/all students will return on Tuesday, September 8.

Academics

- Textbook ordering must be done so that materials are received by the first week of school. Stay tuned for the textbook ordering link.

Health Office

- <u>All students must complete the Family and Health Information Form.</u> This is mandatory for all students and should be completed and sent to the main office before the start of school.

- A complete physical exam certification (within the last 12 months) and a copy of the Immunization Record is required for all students and must be returned by the first week of school.
- All medications must be brought to the Health Clinic during the first week of school along with a signed doctor's order.
- A completed Family and Health Information Form is required for each student. This is mandatory for all students and should be completed by parent/guardian and returned by the first week of school or before.
