Dear Families and Students,

You'd be pleased - and proud - to see the amount of learning that happens in our buildings (and outside) every day. This is a testament to the teachers' dedication and students' perseverance. Through their strong efforts, some good luck, and God's grace, it is working. Let's keep it up!

I write to share a calendar change and a new invitation.

First, the school will be closed, and there will be **no in-person or online classes during Thanksgiving week**, from November 23-27. Originally-scheduled class meetings for Monday, November 23, and Tuesday, November 24, will be converted to "adjustment days" to complete previously-assigned work.

Following Columbus Day, students and teachers will work through five consecutive full weeks (Veterans Day excepted). The reality is that teaching and learning are more arduous this year and, thus, more fatiguing. Therefore, scheduled "breathers" are beneficial - even needed - and will help keep spirits healthy. Also, travel plans and family gatherings pose an increased risk of COVID-19 transmission. Extra time will help families plan their movements more intentionally.

We intend to be in school, in-person, all year. Small measures such as this will help us in this pursuit.

Second, you are invited to our next Town Hall meeting on Tuesday, October 20 (SFXP at 5:30 PM, JPII at 7:00 PM). Now eight weeks into the year, we will provide updates and address your questions and comments. See you online.
