Dear JPII/SFXP Families,

This summer, if someone had said we'd "make it 'til Thanksgiving" fully in-person with only one COVID-positive report in the school, we'd have responded, "Amen to that!" What once seemed likely -- that we'd be forced to 'go remote' -- may well stay on the back burner. No doubt teaching and learning are harder this year, but due to teachers' dedication and students' perseverance, it is working. God willing, we will stay together all year.

I write to share an additional calendar change as we adjust to the year's contours.

Christmas recess will begin after classes on Friday, December 18, 2020, and span two full weeks. The school will be closed, and there will be no in-person or online classes from December 21, 2020, to January 4, 2021. December 21-23 will be considered 'adjustment days' when previously assigned work can be completed. As I wrote when elongating Thanksgiving break to a full week, scheduled 'breathers' help preserve teachers' and students' spirits and energy. Also, because travel plans and family gatherings pose an increased risk of COVID-19 transmission, extra time will help families plan more intentionally.

Also, tomorrow you will receive a request for feedback as part of our annual Parent Satisfaction Survey. Your responses assist us in our yearly planning and, because the survey items are identical each November, they provide an 'apples to apples' point of comparison with years past.
