ALL SCHOOL

Fully Remote from January 4 - 8

Following consultation with local health officials and the Catholic Schools Office, St. John Paul II High School and St. Francis Xavier Preparatory School will shift to remote learning only next week from Monday, January 4 - Friday, January 8. This decision is a precautionary measure due to holiday travel and not the result of COVID-19 transmission within our school. We know school to be a safe place, and this one-week remote learning measure will enable students and staff to return in-person on Monday, January 11 free from excessive quarantining measures.

Classes will be conducted using the normal bell schedule for the week, starting at 8:05 AM. Monday, January 4 is a Day 4.

Travel Advisory

Please note the Massachusetts travel advisory now in effect. This advisory requires that individuals (ages 11 and up) who travel/return to Massachusetts from high-risk states must produce a negative COVID-19 test result (administered up to 72-hours prior to your return to Massachusetts) or quarantine for 10 days upon arrival/return to Massachusetts. Currently, all U.S. states except Hawaii are designated as high-risk. Please send a copy of your test result to the school.

Flu Vaccine Mandate

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health has extended the deadline for flu vaccination through February 28, 2021. Please send such certification of flu vaccination directly to Mrs. Offiler or Mrs. Fox. Should you require a medical exemption, please contact your child's pediatrician to obtain certification. Contact Mr. Keavy directly should you wish to seek a religious exemption.

Financial Assistance for the 2021-2022 School Year

SFXP families wishing to be considered for financial assistance through the Foundation to Advance Catholic Education (FACE) must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. The application is now open. The

deadline for submitting 2019 tax documents and 2020 W-2s is March 5, 2021. If you do not have a 2020 W-2 income, you will be required to submit 2020 tax documents. If you own a business, additional tax documentation may be required. Additionally, a limited number of scholarships are provided through the St. Francis Xavier Preparatory Scholarship Fund. To apply to the SFXP Scholarship Fund, in addition to completing the FACTS application, a letter requesting consideration along with a brief explanation of need should be sent to Mr. Keavy (ckeavy@jp.dfrcs.org) by April 15, 2021.

Winter Sports Update

Due to the rising numbers of Covid-19 cases in our areas, many Cape and Islands schools have pushed back their winter sports. JPII will continue to hold practices, but please note, we continue to adjust the schedules. We hope to post all sports schedules after the new year. This winter, all games will be self-drives; please make sure you fill out the proper transportation form if you are carpooling.

Our athletic practices will continue as scheduled. All winter sports teams have been following the required protocols. Due to the vacation practice schedule, we are confident that sports can continue as originally planned.

Spectator Policy

The Cape & Islands League has determined winter sports spectator policy will be to limit spectators to home fans only. This will be strictly enforced, unlike in the fall. JPII will allow three spectators for both boys and girls basketball and two spectators for boys hockey. The hockey decision is in line with the state-mandated rules for ice hockey rinks. Virtual swim meets will not allow spectators this year. In order to ensure we follow all guidelines, we will be issuing spectator passes directly to the student-athletes. Spectators will need to bring the pass to each game they attend and be required to sign in. These passes can be given to others who want to attend the game, but each student-athlete will not be able to exceed the designated spectators per sport policy.

Financial Assistance for the 2021-2022 School Year

JPII families wishing to be considered for school-based financial aid for the 2021-2022 school year must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. The online application is now open. 2019 tax documents and 2020 W-2s are required. If you do not have a 2020 W-2 income, you will be required to submit 2020 tax documents. If you own a business, additional tax documentation may be required. To be considered for the first round of awards starting March 1, 2021, applications must be completed, with all the necessary documentation, by February 15, 2021.
