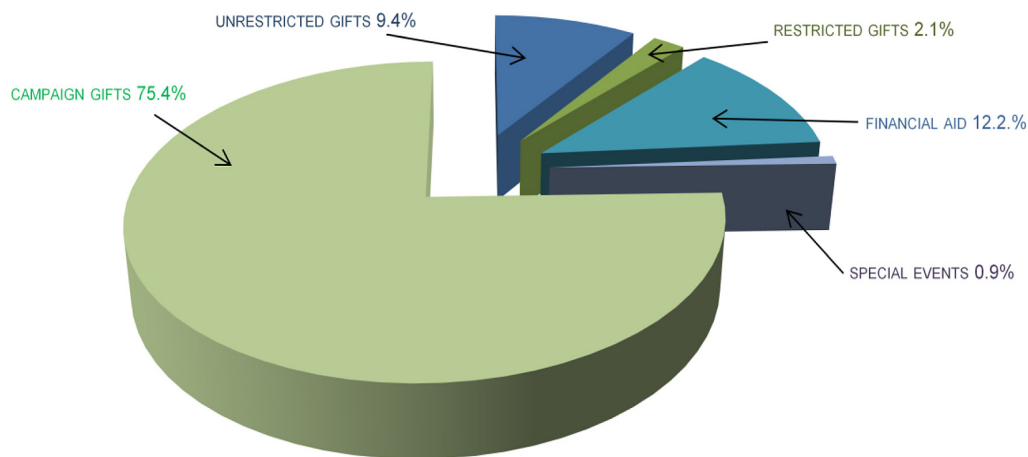
Jesus Himself tells us that when two or three are gathered in His name, He is there among them. Your investment shows your commitment to Catholic education and helps us see the power of the Gospel.

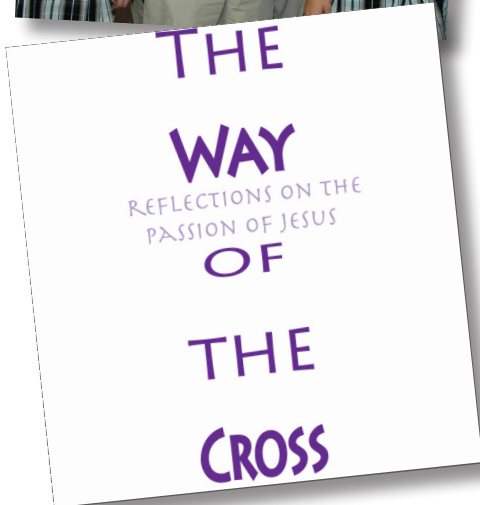

All twenty-seven students were accepted to colleges and universities across the U.S.
