



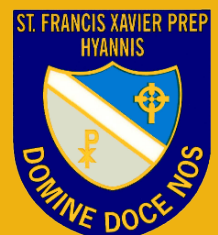

# CHOIR TAKES TO ROME



For many, simply visiting the sites of Rome, Italy is a long-time dream. But for Choir members preparing for the Spring 2017 Choir Tour of Rome, they'll do more than visit. They'll sing and perform in special and sacred places making theirs an educational and spiritual experience of a lifetime.

The JP II Choir and interested SFXP 8th-grade Chorus members will travel, sing, pray, and tour Rome in late February and early March 2017, including Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. Led by School Chaplain Rev. Ron Floyd, who studied in Rome, and Performing Arts Director Richard Fish, the choir is set to perform sacred and secular music at the United States Naval Base in Naples, and the Vatican, thanks to an invitation from the former

Vatican Choir Director. Other performances may include a homeless shelter, hospice (a tradition for the JP II Concert Choir), schools, and churches.

For members, Choir membership and the Vatican tour require a lot of hard work. "Choir isn't something that you can do with half, or partial, effort. Everyone knows when you didn't practice on your own to learn the music. You have to put everything into it. But in the end, you know that it couldn't have been better. You know that all your hard work was worth it when you hear the magic that you created together," explained Meaghan Powell, 17, veteran Choir member and top student.

"I am working two jobs this summer, six or seven, days a week, to help me pay for the trip. But it's worth it. A lot of what we sing in choir praises God. This is an opportunity of a lifetime to be where our Catholic faith emanates from. I am excited to be doing this with some of my closest friends who worship with me through song."

Director Fish's and Fr. Floyd's initiative and experience enabled this big dream to become reality. "This is my twenty-second tour leading choirs all over the country. From my view, it likely represents a 'once in a career' opportunity to sing at the Vatican itself, as well as the U.S. Naval Base in Naples. Both are incredible opportunities for our students. We are very blessed to have this opportunity, which represents the culmination of over five years of building what may be the finest high school choral program in the region. Thank you for your prayers and support as we pursue this noble endeavor. Ad Majoram Dei Gloriam....To the greater glory of God!" Fish explained.

As for her hopes for her time in Italy, Powell said, "I hope that we see Pope Francis, even if it is from a distance. If I could meet anyone alive, it would be the Pope. He is not only a leader for Catholics but a role model."

Fr. Floyd and Mr. Fish have applied to have an audience with the Holy Father. No word yet, but who knows?





# HERE COMES THE SUN



On rainy days, sometimes SFXP Principal, Mrs. Beth Kelley, would hold her breath. When you have a forty-five-year-old roof, water gets in, lockers get wet, and buckets are needed. Even with repairs, the roof's age and deterioration meant a little water here and there was a surprise to no one. Yet the cost of full roof replacement, conservatively estimated at \$200,000, was prohibitive. The school had reserved \$100,000 from a 2014 donation, but even with this, debt seemed unavoidable.

But for solar energy providers, assisting the school with roof replacement in order to install a solar panel array, benefits everyone. With the completion of a full, multi-level roof replacement and solar array installation, the school avoided debt and gained energy savings for the next twenty years. And

the distinction of being the first Catholic entity in the Fall River Diocese to go solar.

This major project was coordinated by the Advisory Board's Facilities Committee, chaired by Steve Tenaglia (Father of James, SFXP '04 and Michael, JPPII '14). Tenaglia and the committee started the process almost two years ago. "The original 1970's era roof was in dire need of replacement. Many details had to fall into place allowing us to accomplish the largest rehab we have undertaken to either of the two buildings. Not only has the roof been replaced, but we are also able to utilize the roof to have a solar array put in place to reduce our carbon footprint significantly. Our students will be able to follow the analytics in real time on this sustainable energy project," Tenaglia said.

Turning Mill, LLC, a Sandwich solar energy company, whose proposal of complete roof replacement and solar panel installation won the job. Thanks to the generosity of (the late) Frank Ward and Eileen Ward and the ingenuity of Turning Mill Energy (Mike Joyce, father of Michael, SFXP '09, and Julianna, SFXP '11 & JPPII '15, is founder), the school now receives energy savings and the benefit of a new roof.

We now have a great result for our SFXP facility, ready now for many more years of high-quality – and dry – middle school education.

On September 4, 2007, an optimistic group of students and families opened a new door for Catholic education on Cape Cod. They were the first class to enter Pope John Paul II High School. 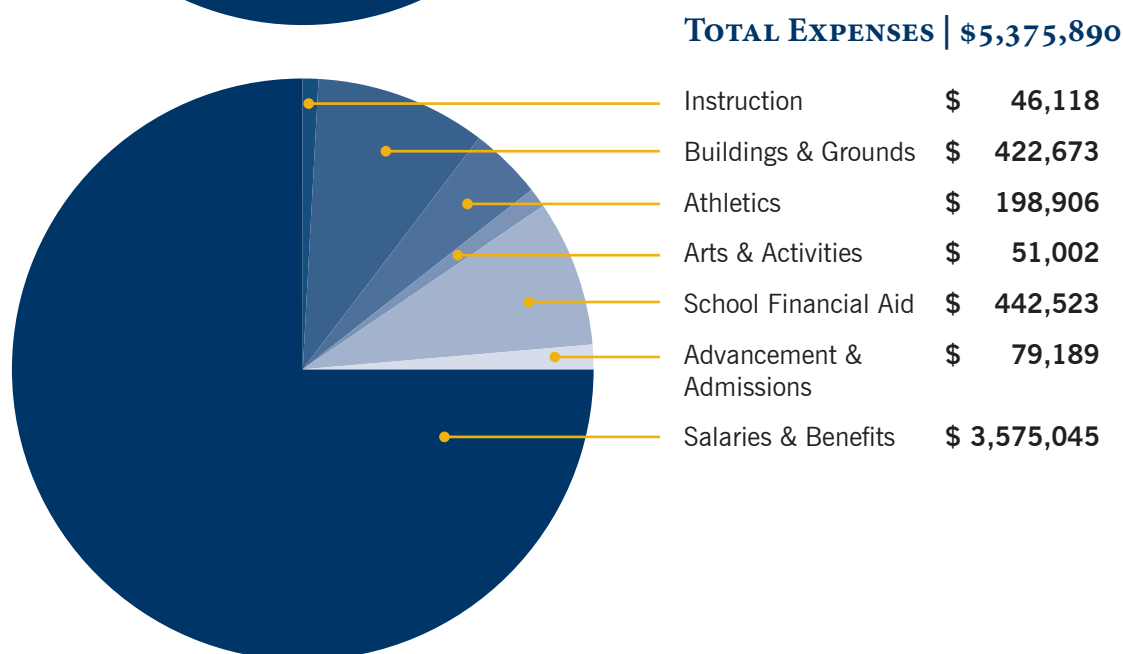
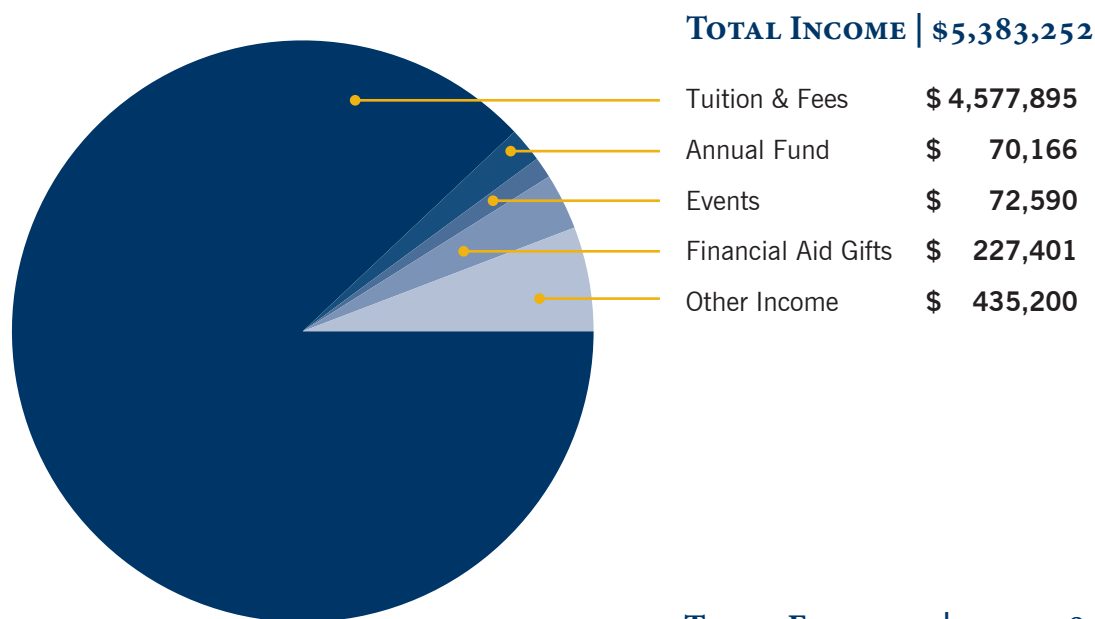
