## **Uniform Update**

As St. John Paul II School advances as one school and in order to achieve consistency across all grade levels, we have initiated minor changes in the school uniform policies. The school is working with Donnelly's Uniform Company to introduce one uniform plaid for the Preparatory Division and High School Division skirts. Grades 5-8 will continue with the kilt style, and Grades 9 through 12 will have an A-line skort. Students may wear either

plaid during this process. This change is also necessitated due to the discontinued stock of the current Preparatory Division skirt. The change in plaid applies to the ties as well, but our eighth-grade ties will remain unique.

The new plaid for the Preparatory Division will be phased in this fall and the high school division skort will be phased in at a later date.
