Financial Assistance for the 2023-2024 School Year

The online application for financial assistance for the 2023-2024 school year is open. To be considered for financial assistance through the Foundation to Advance Catholic Education (FACE) and the JPII Financial Aid Fund, you must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant &

Aid Assessment. The deadline for submitting the application is March 24, 2023. The Financial Aid Committee will carefully review each application upon completion and verification. You are encouraged to submit your application as soon as possible and upload documentation as it becomes available. Please note the following application requirements:

- 2021 IRS Federal Tax Return, including all required schedules.
- All 2022 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both the applicant and co-applicant.
- If applicants do not have W-2 income, the 2022 IRS Federal Tax Return is required. (applicants are asked to contact Mrs. Keras if they plan to file a 2022 tax return extension)

HELPFUL TIPS:

**FACTS frequently emails notices on application status and missing documents. Be sure to add factsmgt.com to your contacts so important emails are not missed.

**The most common issue with delays in processing applications is due to poor quality documents. It is best to scan your documents on a printer or by using the Scan feature on your smartphone instead of the Camera feature. If you require assistance uploading documents, contact Mrs. Keras.

From Ellen Byrd MSN, RN, School Nurse

Flu A is on the rise in our community. Please report any positive flu tests to the School Nurse. Protect your family by practicing good hygiene. Please encourage all students to:

- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
 Put your used tissue in the waste basket.
- Wash hands often with soap and warm water for 20 seconds, especially after touching tissues with secretions after coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.
- You can also consider wearing a high-quality, well-fitting face mask which may help reduce the spread of respiratory germs.
- If your child becomes sick with flu illness, CDC recommends that they stay home for at least 24 hours after their fever is gone and their symptoms have improved or resolved. (The fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) A fever is defined as 100°F (37.8°C)* or higher

A limited supply of free take-home Covid tests are available upon request. First come, first served. Students and staff can request 2 boxes per person which equal 4 tests. These test are meant for home use only. No Covid tests will be done in school by the nurse at this time due to state regulations. Consider requesting tests to use prior to returning to school after the holiday breaks.
