

## <u>Grades 9-12</u> Financial Assistance for the 2023-2024 School Year

The online application for financial assistance for the 2023-2024 school year is open. To be considered for financial assistance through the JPII Financial Aid Fund you must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. For the first round of awards starting March 1, 2023, applications must be completed, with all the necessary documentation, by February 15, 2023. The Financial Aid Committee will carefully review each application upon completion and verification. *You are encouraged to submit your application as soon as possible and upload documentation as it becomes available.* Please note the following application requirements:

- 2021 IRS Federal Tax Return, including all required schedules.
- All 2022 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both the applicant and co-applicant.
- If applicants do not have W-2 income, the 2022 IRS Federal Tax Return is required. (applicants are asked to contact Mrs. Keras if they plan to file a 2022 tax return extension)

## **HELPFUL TIPS:**

\*\*FACTS frequently emails notices on application status and missing documents. Be sure to add **factsmgt.com** to your contacts so important emails are not missed.

\*\*The most common issue with delays in processing applications is due to poor quality documents. It is best to scan your documents on a printer or by using the Scan feature on your smartphone instead of the Camera feature. If you require assistance uploading documents, contact Mrs. Keras.
