From the Health Office

Starting mid-April, Cynthia Roche, Diocesan Adjustment Counselor, will conduct a health screening called SBIRT. SBIRT stands for Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment. SBIRT is used to screen for alcohol, nicotine, tobacco, and other drug use. This health screening is required by Massachusetts law.

Students in grades 7 and 10 will participate in this screening which takes about 5-10 minutes. Look for the parent information letter in your emails. If you prefer to opt out of this screening, please inform your school's nurse by April 10. Thank you.
