

Concert Choir Performance Dates May through June 2023

Wednesday, March 29 at 5:00 PM: Concert Choir sings for Stations of the Cross at St. Elizabeth in Falmouth (5 PM Arrival; 5:30 Stations, followed by pizza dinner for the choir with treats. We should be done by about 6:45 PM.)
