

# **Testing**

On Wednesday, October 11, all students in grades 9 - 11 will take the PSAT college readiness test, and grade 12 students will take the SAT college entrance exam at no additional cost to families.

Starting this year, the PSAT will be offered in a digital format only. The test requires that students have a Windows or Mac laptop or an iPad, on which

to install the required testing application. The testing app is not compatible with student Chromebooks. This is a College Board requirement. In order to ensure that all students in grades 9 - 11 are able to take the PSAT test, please make sure that your students have access to a Windows or Mac laptop or an iPad, on Wednesday, October 11. The school will have a contingency plan in place for students with technology issues. See the College Board website for more information.

The SAT exam for grade 12 students will still be administered on paper, so no additional technology is required.

On Monday, October 2, students will install the required Bluebook App on their laptops in their English classes. Again, students with personal Chromebooks cannot install the app and must make arrangements to have access to a Windows or Mac laptop, or an iPad. There will no longer be a paper option for the PSAT test.

In order to ensure that all families can visit with teachers, we will strive to keep conferences to five minutes.
