Additional Fees

- All parents pay an annual **Registration Fee** of \$175 per student. This fee is non-refundable and covers the scheduling and staffing costs incurred in the current school year. Please note that the registration fee will be applied to your FACTS account in June. A separate payment to the school is not required.
- Families of **Grade 12** students are assessed a graduation fee of \$300. This fee covers senior banquet expenses, yearbook costs, baccalaureate and graduation expenses, and other events. This fee will be added to your FACTS account in June.
- The **Grade 8** trip to Washington, D.C. is an additional cost that can be paid in full or through a FACTS payment plan. Trip details and cost will be available summer 2024.
- Annual **Athletics Fee** of \$125 for students participating in high school athletics. *This annual fee is per student, not per sport.* This fee will be invoiced during the school year, through FACTS.

Continuous Enrollment

Families sign one enrollment contract that will keep their children enrolled automatically. If your child will not be returning for the next school year, please request a Notice of Withdrawal from the Admissions Office and return it no later than May 15. Students who withdraw after May 15 will be assessed a late withdrawal fee of \$500.

FACTS Management handles the billing and payment processing for all tuition payments.

NEW STUDENTS:

You must create a tuition agreement with FACTS Management. Once you have completed your online Enrollment Packet, please log into your Family Portal account and choose the Financial option to create your payment plan. Once you have completed this process, the school will enter your tuition information. You will receive a confirmation from FACTS once your agreement has been finalized.

RETURNING STUDENTS:

The school will update your FACTS account with 2024-2025 tuition amounts. Once this is complete, a verification email will be sent to the email address on file. When you receive this email, it is important to check your FACTS account to verify the accuracy of information.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

PAYMENT IN FULL

- Due on June 1.
- Automatic withdrawal from a checking/savings account or credit cards are accepted – a 2.95% convenience fee is assessed by FACTS for credit card payments.
- You may elect to receive an "Invoice" from FACTS. When choosing this option you can make a one-time payment online or over the phone or mail a check directly to FACTS or the school.
- There is a \$25 enrollment fee per family assessed by FACTS.

MONTHLY PAYMENTS

- 12 months, beginning in June, 2024 and ending in May, 2025.
- Payments can be made on the 5th or 20th of each month.
- Automatic withdrawal from a checking/savings account is required.
- There is a \$55 enrollment fee per family assessed by FACTS.

ADDITIONAL TUITION INFORMATION

Sibling Discount

Sibling discounts will be applied from Grade 5-Grade 12. The oldest child will be charged full tuition and a 5% discount will be applied to each subsequent child. Any additional financial aid awards will be applied to the balance.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Applications must be submitted annually to be considered for need-based aid. All awards are reviewed based upon the timely completion of the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Form, continued demonstrated financial need, good standing at JPII, and availability of resources. JPII Financial Aid Fund

Applications for Grades 9-12 must be completed by December 31, 2023 in order to be considered in the first-round notification of awards. Awards are then made on a rolling basis.

Applications for Grades 5-8 must be completed by March 24, 2024 in order to be considered in the first-round notification of awards. Awards are then made on a rolling basis. Funds are limited and families are encouraged to apply early.

Parish Assistance

Parents of children registered at Catholic parishes may request parish assistance from their pastor. The Parish Assistance form can be found on the JPII website (Afford Tab). It is the family's responsibility to present the request form to their pastor for approval and arrange to have the form returned to the school.
