The solar eclipse will occur on Monday, April 8, during dismissal times. While Massachusetts is not in the direct path of totality, we will still see about 90-95 percent of the eclipse. The eclipse will begin at 2:13 P.M. and reach maximum coverage at 3:27 P.M. before ending at 4:37 P.M. From the Health Office

It is time for our annual Health Screenings. From the weeks following April vacation until the end of the school year, our School Nurses will conduct various health screens as required by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. If screening results indicate the need for follow-up care by a physician, parents/guardians will be notified.

The schedule of the screenings at St. John Paul II School is as follows:

Grades 5-8: Postural (Scoliosis)

Grade 6: Vision and Hearing

Grade 9: Vision, Hearing, and Postural (Scoliosis)

Grade 10: Body Mass Index (BMI) and SBIRT screening ---SBIRT stands for Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment. SBIRT screens for alcohol, nicotine, tobacco, and other drug use. It will be done using the CRAFFT screening tool (for more information, contact Ellen Byrd at ebyrd@jpiihyannis.org). This health screening is required by Massachusetts law.

As with all health screenings, you or your child may opt-out. If you would like to opt out of one or more of these screenings, please email or call the school nurse no later than April 19.
