The Knights of Columbus, Council 13388, of Christ the King Parish Catholic High School Scholarship.

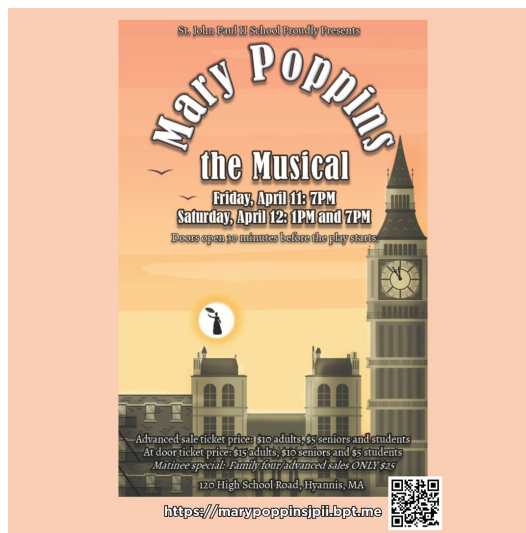

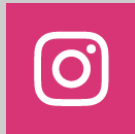
