

#### From the Health Offices:

It is time for our annual health screenings. In the weeks following April vacation, until the end of the school year, our School Nurses will conduct various health screenings as required by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. If screening results indicate the need for follow-up care by a physician, parents/guardians will be notified.

The schedule of the screenings at St. John Paul II School is as follows:

Entire Prep Division: Postural (Scoliosis)

**6th Grade**: Vision and Hearing

9th Grade: Vision, Hearing, and Postural (Scoliosis)

**10th Grade**: Body Mass Index (BMI) and SBIRT screening-SBIRT stands for Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment. SBIRT is used to screen for alcohol, nicotine, tobacco, and other drug use. SBIRT screening will be done using the CRAFFT screening tool (contact Allison McLeod or Ellen Byrd for questions).
