



## **BREAKFAST AND LUNCH PROGRAM 2025 - 2026**

JPII is excited to continue our partnership with Barnstable Public Schools Food Services, and offer the [The National School Breakfast and Lunch Program](#) for the 2025-2026 school year. Not only does this program provide multiple benefits for our students and families, it fosters a healthier environment for learning.

Please note that the program differs between the two buildings, so please read the specifics for each building.

### **For Grades 5-8:**

- Students will be provided **one** free breakfast daily.
- Students will be provided **one** free lunch daily. A bagged sandwich lunch is offered on early dismissal days.
- Breakfast is available from 7:15-7:50 A.M. in Monsignor Thomson Hall. Students are expected to finish their breakfast before leaving Monsignor Thomson Hall. If your child would prefer to save their breakfast for lunch or for afterschool, they may store their breakfast in their backpack.
- Same day lunch orders and next day breakfast orders will be taken during your child's homeroom period. There are two breakfast choices and students may choose from three lunch options (hot meal option, sandwich option, salad option). **If your child is tardy and would like to order lunch, their order will be taken upon arrival at the office. Arrivals after 10:30AM cannot be accommodated.**

**For Grades 9-12:**

- Students will be provided **one** free breakfast daily.
- Students will be provided **one** free lunch daily. A bagged sandwich lunch is offered on early dismissal days.
- Breakfast will be available from 7:15-8:00 A.M. in the cafeteria. Students are expected to finish their breakfast before leaving the cafeteria. If your child would prefer to save their breakfast for lunch or for afterschool, they may store their breakfast in their backpack.
- Pre-ordering is not required for breakfast or lunch.
- Additional meals can be purchased with cash.
