# SAT/PSAT Day will be on Thursday, October 16

ALL students in grades 9-12 will take either the PSAT or the SAT on Thursday, October 16 as part of their school day. Students will be dismissed at 11:24 AM.

12th Grade: SAT

10th and 11th Grade: PSAT/NMSQT

9th Grade: PSAT 8/9

- 1. All students must arrive at school on time. Students who arrive late to school on the morning of testing risk not being allowed to test.
- 2. Before test day, students must have installed Bluebook on their devices. They can log into their College Board accounts and <u>download the app</u>. Be advised that the College Board often runs software updates to Bluebook. Before test day, students are advised to run Bluebook to allow an autoupdate, if there is one, to proceed.
- 3. It is critical that students bring their devices to school on test day fully charged—capable of running on battery power for up to 4 hours. Access to a power outlet during testing cannot be guaranteed.
- 4. Students who use personal Chromebooks will not be able to use them on test day. Instead, they will test on one of the school's managed devices. Students will need to know their College Board sign-in credentials (username and password).
