

Grades 9-12 Financial Assistance for the 2026-2027 School Year

Please read through this information carefully to ensure timely and accurate submission of your application.

The online application for financial assistance for the 2026-2027 school year is open. To be considered for financial assistance through the JPII Financial Aid Fund you must complete an application each year with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. For the first round of awards starting January 31, 2026, applications must be completed, with all the necessary documentation, by **December 31, 2025**. Applications completed after this date are awarded on a rolling basis depending on availability of funds. *You are encouraged to submit your application as soon as possible and upload documentation as it becomes available.*

Please note the following application requirements:

- 2024 IRS Federal Tax Return, including all required schedules.
- There is a \$45 application fee collected by FACTS and paid upon submission of the application.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Co-applicants must be included on applications. If your current marital status is married, co-applicant information is required.
- If your current marital status is divorced, the parent responsible for payment of the tuition completes and submits the application. If each divorced parent is responsible for a portion of the tuition, each parent should complete and submit separate applications.





HELPFUL TIPS:

- **NEW! IRS Integration. Highly recommended!** You can save time by using FACTS IRS Integration, which securely sends your tax transcripts directly from the IRS to your submitted application. <u>Watch this video</u> to learn more (the password is IRS).
- FACTS frequently emails notices on application status and missing documents. Be sure to add **factsmgt.com** to your contacts so important emails are not missed.
- The most common issue with delays in processing applications is due to poor quality documents. Documents must be clear and no parts cut off. It is best to scan your documents on a printer or by using the <u>Scan feature</u> on your smartphone *instead* of the <u>Camera feature</u>. If you require assistance uploading documents, contact Mrs. Keras.
