**9th Grade:** Vision and Hearing

**10th Grade:** Body Mass Index (BMI) and SBIRT screening- SBIRT stands for Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment. SBIRT is used to screen for alcohol, nicotine, tobacco, and other drug use. SBIRT screening will be done using the CRAFFT screening tool (contact [Alison McLeod](#) or [Ellen Byrd](#) for questions).
