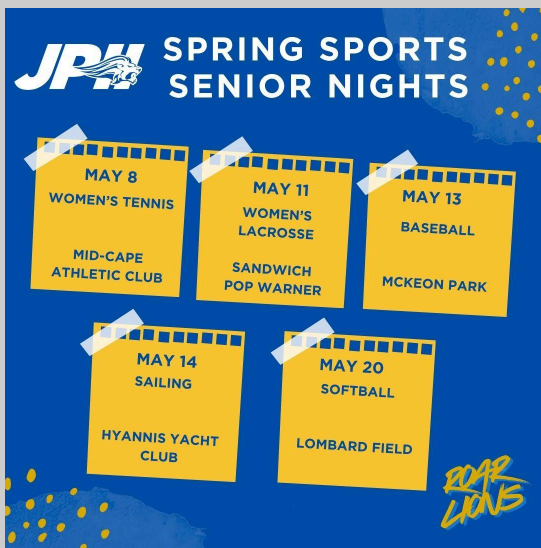
Used Uniforms
