We are proud to offer "over the bridge" transportation exclusively for St. Francis Xavier and St. John Paul II students daily.

Pick-up/drop-off at one of three stops in Bourne, Plymouth, Sagamore and travel directly to SFXP/JPII in Hyannis.

For 2020-2021, the school will provide a 100% subsidy of the approx. \$1,700 annual cost. Therefore, in order to be issued a bus pass, all families must do is sign-up online. *A student must be registered for 2020-2021 to sign-up and receive a bus pass.
