FACTS SIS Family Portal

This year, the school discontinued use of the ParentsPlus system in favor of FACTS SIS as the school information system (SIS) provider. We believe that FACTS SIS will provide you better information in an easier manner. Therefore, your ParentsPlus portal is no longer active, and <u>every family must create a new login in FACTS SIS Family Portal to access grades, attendance, and the like</u>. Face Masks

Please note that face masks are a public health measure that the schools of the Diocese of Fall River are requiring of all students in grades two through twelve. Additionally, all students, regardless of their grade level, are required to wear a face mask during school bus transportation to and from school.

We are following the state guidances issued by MA Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) regarding these requirements of mask/face coverings in our school communities. These coverings must cover both the person's nose and mouth.

In the event a student is unable to wear a face mask for any reason, our schools are happy to provide your child with a remote learning option.

Hand Sanitizer

JPII and SFXP will have hand sanitizer available for use by students and staff while in school as an effective alternative for cleaning hands if soap and water are not readily available. Hand sanitizer (with at least 60% alcohol) is recommended as an alternative to soap and water by CDC and the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. Parents/legal guardians are allowed to opt their child out of using hand sanitizer by sending a written notice to the school.

Barnstable Public Schools Transportation

Due to Barnstable Public Schools' delayed school opening, transportation provided by the District shall commence on Monday, September 28. Arrangements are made through the Barnstable Public Schools' Transportation Department.
