- Visit this website: https://sjpfx-ma.client.renweb.com/pw/
- Select "Student," then click "Create New ParentsWeb Account."
- Enter the Student's JPII email address; FACTS will send an email for account setup.
- From the email, click the link to create your password; a new window will open.
- Leave the student's JPII email address as the username.
- Type a new password, then confirm the password and save.

You may now log into FamilyPortal as a student using your JPII email and password. (https://sjpfx-ma.client.renweb.com/pw/ select "Student")

Dress Code Update

The weather is beginning to get cool, and to ensure the safety and health of our students, we are keeping windows open in the classrooms. To ensure our students are warm, we are making a minor adjustment to the standard JPII dress code. Beginning on Monday, students will be allowed to wear JPII sweatshirts, JPII warm-up jackets, and JPII sweaters inside the school. No other sweatshirts or warm-up jackets will be allowed.

Pickup & Drop-off

Parents picking up or dropping off students at the high school should enter via Pine Ave. and drive behind the building. There is no pickup or dropoff in the front circle.

JPII Athletics

Sports tryouts and practices will be held this week. Students will be allowed to use the locker rooms but under strict guidance. There will be no more than six students allowed in the locker room at one time. Male student-athletes may enter the weight room doors and put their bag in the locker room, and then exit through the weight room doors. Female student-athletes may enter through the locker room doors and exit through the weight room doors. No bags may be left in the locker room overnight. Students must wash all gear and spray their bags. Please make sure all Fall 1 athletes have completed family ID by Monday.

JPII Football will be meeting Monday after school. Anyone interested in playing football in grades 8-12 must attend. Football will start practices on Monday, September 28, but will not compete in games until Fall 2 (February 22). If you have any questions, please contact Coach Fazzi.
