- From the email, click the link to create your password; a new window will open.
- Leave the student's JPII email address as the username.
- Type a new password, then confirm the password and save.

All seniors will take the SAT beginning at 8 am. Freshmen will take the PSAT 8/9 at the same time. Sophomores and juniors will stay at home and participate in a remote learning day. After the tests, seniors will be dismissed for the day and freshmen will attend their afternoon classes in person. Students may dress down on that day in JPII gear; normal dress-down rules apply. Juniors and sophomores will take the PSAT on Thursday, October 29. Stay tuned for more information.
