Timeline: Thursday, June 3, 2021

New Seabury Country Club, New Seabury, 7:15 – 10:30

- 7:15 - Entry to prom
- 7:30 – No entry to prom after this time

School Dismissal Guidelines:

- Juniors: There is no early dismissal on June 3. You must be in school to attend prom. Students attending prom may take an excused day off on June 4.

Guest Forms: All guest forms must be completed and submitted to Ms. Valentino by 3:00 on Wednesday, May 26. Guest forms must include a copy of a photo ID and Reminder that all guests must present a photo ID at the door.

Chemical Health: Prom is a chemical free school event (drug, tobacco, vaping, and alcohol free). Any student that violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action as described in the Student Handbook. A police officer will be present to promote a safe and healthy environment. Students may be required to submit to a breathalyzer test.

COVID Guidelines: All Mask and Social Distancing Guidelines must be followed.

Dress Code Guidelines:

- Dresses should not have open or bare midriffs, cut-outs on the stomach or sides. If you have cut-outs, cover with fabric.
