COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic

The school has been afforded the opportunity to offer an on-site COVID-19 vaccination clinic for students and families. Any JPII/SFXP student or family member of a student is eligible to sign-up. The clinic will be held in the SFXP gym on **Sunday, May 23**, starting at 1 PM.

If you would like your child(ren) to receive the Pfizer 12+ vaccination at school, you must complete this interest form <u>here.</u>

We need your response by Monday, 5/17 in order to determine the number of doses we will require. Once you have expressed interest through this form, we will follow up with necessary paperwork and your appointment time.

Some have asked about vaccination protocols for the fall. Currently, there is no requirement that students be vaccinated in order to return and the school will not require such unless directly required to do so by public health officials.

We are grateful to Cape Cod Healthcare and Whole Health Pharmacy (who will administer the program) for including St. John Paul II High School and St. Francis Xavier Preparatory School in their rollout plans.

Mass. Travel Advisory

All visitors entering Massachusetts, including returning residents, are advised to quarantine for 10 days upon their arrival. Travelers in the following categories are exempt from this quarantine advisory:

- Travelers who have received a negative COVID-19 result on a test administered not more than 72 hours prior to their arrival in Massachusetts. Travelers may also test out of the quarantine advisory after arrival in Massachusetts, as long as they quarantine until receiving a negative test result.
- Anyone who is returning to Massachusetts after being out of the State for fewer than 24 hours
- Travelers who are fully vaccinated (i.e. who have received two doses of either the Moderna or Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines OR who have received a single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, 14 days or more ago) and who do not have symptoms.

Financial Assistance for the 2021-2022 School Year

JPII families wishing to be considered for school-based financial aid for the 2021-2022

school year must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. The online application is now open. 2019 tax documents and 2020 W-2s are required. If you do not have a 2020 W-2 income, you will be required to submit 2020 tax documents. If you own a business, additional tax documentation may be required. To be considered for the first round of awards starting March 1, 2021, applications must be completed, with all the necessary documentation, by February 15, 2021.
