After Care begins Tuesday, September 7

After Care is for students who are not picked up at the conclusion of the school day or at the conclusion of a sponsored sports event, silent study hall, or school activity. Students may have a snack, work on homework, and socialize. After Care, hours are 3:00 pm - 5:30 pm. Parent or guardian

must sign out student at pick-up. The After Care cost is \$5.00 per half-hour. There is a \$5.00 per minute charge for students left in After Care after 5:30. Parents will be invoiced once each month. The After Care Program will not be operational on half days or on the day prior to the start of vacation.

Study Hall begins on Wednesday, September 8

Silent Study Hall is held from 3:00 P.M. until 4:00 P.M. If a child stays for the Silent Study Hall, he/she must be picked up at 4:00 P.M. There is no charge for the silent study hall. However, a student must stay for the full hour. Parents may not disturb the study hall to pick up a child early. If the child is not picked up from the Silent Study Hall by 4:15 P.M., he/she will be brought to the After-Care room. The Study Hall Program will not be operational on half days or on the day prior to the start of vacation.

Select Chorus Auditions

Auditions for the Preparatory Division Select Chorus will take place on the next "Day 1" (Monday, September 13) at Noon, with Mr. Fish. Mr. Fish will come to lunch that day, and bring auditioning students over to the auditorium at the high school for auditions. Auditions are open to all prep school students!
