

# Tuition and Financial Information 2022-2023

St. John Paul II School	Tuition 2022-2023
High School Division (Grades 9-12)	\$13,020
Preparatory Division (Grades 5-8)	\$9,700

Many factors contribute to the determination of tuition; school expenses and new program costs, anticipated financial aid requests, and expected gifts to the school. The 2022-2023 tuition compares favorably with typical private and parochial school tuition and represents strong value and return on investment.

# Additional Fees

- All parents pay an annual registration fee of \$175 per student. This fee is non-refundable and covers the scheduling and staffing costs incurred in the current school year. Please note that the registration fee will be applied to the tuition bill in June. A separate payment to the school is not required.
- Families of **Grade 12** students are assessed a graduation fee of \$300. This fee covers senior banquet expenses, yearbook costs, baccalaureate and graduation expenses, and other events.
- The **Grade 8** trip to Washington, D.C. is an additional cost that can be paid in full or through a FACTS Management payment plan.

# **Continuous Enrollment**

Families sign one enrollment contract that will keep their children enrolled automatically, or until they say otherwise, with no need to complete re-enrollment contracts each year.

- <u>If your child is returning for the 2022-2023 school year</u>, your child will be re-enrolled automatically for the 2022-2023 school year, and your registration fee will be applied to your tuition account in June.
- If you know that your child will not be returning for the 2022-2023 school year, please complete a written notice of withdrawal and submit to the Admissions Office no later than May 15.

Once a continuous enrollment contract has been signed, students who withdraw (opt-out) after May 15 will be assessed a late withdrawal fee of \$500. Families who submit a notice of withdrawal before May 15 will not incur this fee.

# PAYMENT OPTIONS

FACTS Management handles the billing and payment processing for all tuition payments.

#### **NEW STUDENTS:**

You must create a tuition agreement with FACTS Management. Please log into your Family Portal account and choose the Financial option to create your payment plan. Once you have completed this process, the school will enter your tuition information. You will receive a confirmation from FACTS once your agreement has been finalized.

#### **RETURNING STUDENTS:**

The school will update your FACTS account with 2022-2023 tuition amounts. Once this is complete, a verification email will be sent to the email address on file. When you receive this email, it is important to check your FACTS account to verify the accuracy of information.

### THE TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS ARE:

# PAYMENT IN FULL

- Due on June 1.
- Automatic withdrawal from a checking/savings account or credit cards are accepted – a 2.85% convenience fee is assessed by FACTS for credit card payments.
- You may elect to receive an "Invoice" from FACTS. When choosing this option you can make a one-time payment online or over the phone or mail a check directly to FACTS.
- There is a \$20 enrollment fee per family assessed by FACTS.

#### MONTHLY PAYMENTS

- 12 months, beginning in June, 2022 and ending in May, 2023.
- Payments can be made on the 5th or 20th of each month.
- Automatic withdrawal from a checking/savings account is required.
- There is a \$50 enrollment fee per family assessed by FACTS.

## INVESTMENT

The benefits of Catholic education are widely known. The overall value of a JPII education – academic achievement, spiritual formation, opportunity, community – is an investment in the adult your child is becoming. The investment that you make now will appreciate as your child grows through college and into family, community, business, civic, and Church life.

### **FINANCIAL AID**

To be considered for financial aid, FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application must be submitted and verified for all families. Financial aid applications must be completed annually. The application can be found online at: <u>online.factsmgt.com/aid</u>. Need-based financial aid is determined based on information provided through FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment.

#### For students entering Grades 5-8

#### Foundation to Advance Catholic Education

Need-based financial aid is distributed through FACE -Foundation to Advance Catholic Education. The school will notify parents of FACE awards. Should you need to request additional financial aid from the school, please submit a letter with a brief explanation of need to the Financial Aid Committee (direct letters to Margaret Keras, Student Accounts Coordinator, mkeras@jpiihyannis.org) by May 15.

#### **Parish Assistance**

Parents of children registered at Catholic parishes may request parish assistance from their pastor. The Parish Assistance form can be found on the JPII website (Admissions>Afford>Tuition>Fin ancial Aid & Scholarships>Parish Subsidy Form). It is the family's responsibility to present the request form to their pastor for approval and arrange to have the form returned to the school.

#### For students entering Grades 9-12

#### JPII Financial Aid

Need-based financial aid is distributed through the school. JPII provides financial assistance through its scholarship fund. First round awards begin on March 1.

#### ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL AID OPPORTUNITIES

#### Sibling Discount

Sibling discounts will be applied from Grade 5-Grade 12. The oldest child will be charged ful tuition and a 5% discount will be applied to each subsequent child. Any additional financial aid awards will be applied to the balance.

The **Brazilian Catholic Leadership Scholarship** is open to Brazilian Catholics who demonstrate leadership and achievement. This scholarship is available to students entering **Grade 5** or **Grade 9**. The scholarship is for ½ tuition and applies to Grade 5 or Grade 9 only. To be eligible students and their families must:

- Complete the application process and be accepted to Grade 5 or Grade 9.
- Complete the Scholarship Application for consideration.
- Be of Brazilian descent.
- Be actively involved in their local Catholic parish community.
- Demonstrate school or community leadership.
- Complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Financial Assistance application.
