Financial Assistance for the 2022-2023 School Year

The online application for financial assistance for the 2022-2023 school year is open. To be considered for financial assistance through the Foundation to Advance Catholic Education (FACE), you must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. The deadline to be considered for the first round of awards was March 11. You may still apply and are encouraged to do so *as soon as possible*. *If you have applied but have not received confirmation that your application is complete, be sure to review your application for what information or documents are missing.*

Please note the following application requirements:

- 2020 IRS Federal Tax Return including any required schedules.
- 2021 W-2 forms for both the applicant and co-applicant.
- If applicants do not have W-2 income 2021, IRS Federal Tax Returns are requested. (applicants are asked to contact Mrs. Keras if they plan to file a 2021 tax return extension)
