Financial Assistance for the 2022-2023 School Year

The online application for financial assistance for the 2022-2023 school year is open. To be considered for financial assistance through the Foundation to Advance Catholic Education (FACE), you must complete an annual application with FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. The deadline to be considered for the first round of awards was March 11. You may still apply and are encouraged to do so as soon as possible. If you have applied but have not received confirmation that your application is complete, be sure to review your application for what information or documents are missing.

Please note the following application requirements:

- 2020 IRS Federal Tax Return including any required schedules.
- 2021 W-2 forms for both the applicant and co-applicant.
- If applicants do not have W-2 income 2021, IRS Federal Tax Returns are requested. (applicants are asked to contact Mrs. Keras if they plan to file a 2021 tax return extension)
