- School Store: The school store will be open from 3:00 - 5:00 on August 17.

Health Office

- All medications must be brought to the Health Clinic during the first week of school along with a signed doctor's note.
- A complete physical exam certification (within the last 13 months) and a copy of the Immunization Record are required for all students and must be returned by the first week of school.

Auditions for the Fall Play (Drama Club) will take place during the first full week of school. Drama Club is open to all JPPI students for both actors and production staff.
