# John Milligan '13

## Leadership and Advocacy

Long before the adoption of the current mission statement in 2022, John Milligan embodied the principles of "continuous learning, respect, and community leadership." As a proud graduate of one of the first classes at St. John Paul II School, John sowed the seeds of growth and change, contributing to the formation of enduring traditions that continue to this day. A trailblazer in his own right, he lobbied, advocated, and inspired others to establish practices that still continue. Notably, John was a key member of the inaugural football team, an experience that instilled in him the importance of motivating others toward a shared cause.

John has consistently sought positive change and growth in every organization he has been a part of. His bold facilitation skills, honed at JPIL, transitioned into his college years, where he contributed to the student senate at College of the



Holy Cross. Having graduated from Holy Cross in 2017, John resolved to leverage the seeds of knowledge planted during his time in founding Principal, Mr. Keavy's office where he advocated for meaningful change at JPIL into a career in the political realm.

Reflecting on John's time at JPIL, Ms. Valentino, Assistant Head of School, Grades 9-12 remarked, "He always led from the front, an excellent student who collaborated with the Student Council and Administration to initiate new endeavors, contributing to the continuous improvement of school culture."

John's commitment to his alma mater extends beyond his graduation. In August 2023, Advancement/ Admissions Director, Mrs Canzano asked him to become involved at JPIL once again. This conversation led to the establishment of an Alumni Network for the school. Taking the lead, John has revitalized alumni attendance at annual events such as Fall Fest, the Thanksgiving Football game, and a Christmas Break meeting. His behind-the-scenes efforts have played a pivotal role in reinvigorating the alumni community, working closely with the administration to advocate for new traditions at JPIL.

# Sadie O'Connor '18

**D**uring her days at JPIL, Sadie O'Connor could always be found in the auditorium, so it comes as no surprise that she continued pursuing the arts, majoring in English and Music at College of the Holy Cross. Unlike so many people, though, Sadie has refused to let music simply be a passion—for her, it's a profession. Sadie is now a Master's student at the Jacob School of Music, Indiana, where she is pursuing a career in Shakespearean Theater and Opera Performance.

Sadie's first musical at JPIL, all the way back in 5th grade, was *Into the Woods*, and this is just one of dozens of shows she's starred in since.

In addition to playing Cinderella, some of her favorite roles have been Amalia in *She Loves Me* and Puck in an international staging of

*Midsummer Night's Dream*. On the academic side, she has published several papers on literary criticism and participated in antiracist initiatives. For Sadie, music and art **"create community and positive change, especially for young people,"** and she's particularly passionate about arts advocacy.

It is this passion that led to her most important project yet. Last year, she founded and led an independent opera company called **Unsung Operas**. The purpose of this organization was to translate, stage, and film several operas written by women, which, because of their creators' identities, had never been performed. This massive project involved applying for (and winning) grants, transcribing and translating 18th and 19th-century texts, and managing a cast of thirty people. It was a massive success. The album and recordings are now in post-production and should be available soon. Sadie hopes to take this project further and is currently applying for grants that would allow her to perform these operas throughout France!

Sadie has always loved the arts and credits her time at JPIL, and Performing Arts Director Deacon Fish, with teaching her how to engage with it professionally. In part, this meant a constantly rotating schedule of choir tours, plays, and concerts which helped her learn to manage her time. More importantly, though, JPIL taught her that **"all work can be a faith-based mission, especially when artistic, especially when it involves people."** It is Sadie's faith that drives her to connect people through music, across space and time, for the good of all.

Asked what advice she'd give a current student interested in her field, Sadie said **"know why you're doing it, why you love it...Don't tie your worth as an artist to whether someone likes you.... There is no such thing as being good enough; your being is good enough."**





# Christopher Bresnahan '19

## FAITH & SCIENCE

**D**uring his time at St. John Paul II School, Chris Bresnahan was recognized for his leadership skills, faith, and dedication to service. He actively served as a retreat leader at school and was highly involved in ECHO (Encountering Christ in Others) of Cape Cod, which played a significant role in his faith formation. Additionally, his experience of participating in JPIL's service trip to Ecuador ignited his passion for non-traditional learning experiences and his love for travel.

Chris combined science with spirituality by pursuing a dual degree in Biology and Theology at Providence College. At PC, he published his first theology paper in an academic journal and his first biology paper is currently in peer review.

Chris was the recipient of the Father Smith OP Fellowship. This Fellowship awards students from Providence College the opportunity to travel anywhere in the world to engage in study and/or service. This led him to Manila, Philippines, where he performed biology research with Fr. Nicanor Austriaco on two separate

projects. One project's goal was to create a novel vaccine delivery system using genetically altered yeast to produce a spike protein for a given disease, including COVID-19, Swine Flu, and TB. The other used yeast as a model organism for rice plants that were genetically modified to discern possible resistance to drought, heat and other factors.

As Chris reflects, "St. John Paul II School draws out the part of our nature that is ordained to excellence. Oftentimes, we are tempted to think that we are hindered in this pursuit by our own littleness. On the contrary, it is this very littleness, when guided in humility to the Cross of Jesus where it is taken up to heaven with Him, that is made magnanimous. The words that began St. John Paul II's papacy, "Be Not Afraid," should resound to occupy the place of that temptation. It resounds at JPIL, where students are given a vision of the faith, of success, of leadership, passion, learning. This vision is presented in a way that does not cause fear of these things, as if they are out of reach. St. John Paul II presents them as what we are ordained to, because they are what we are made to attain."

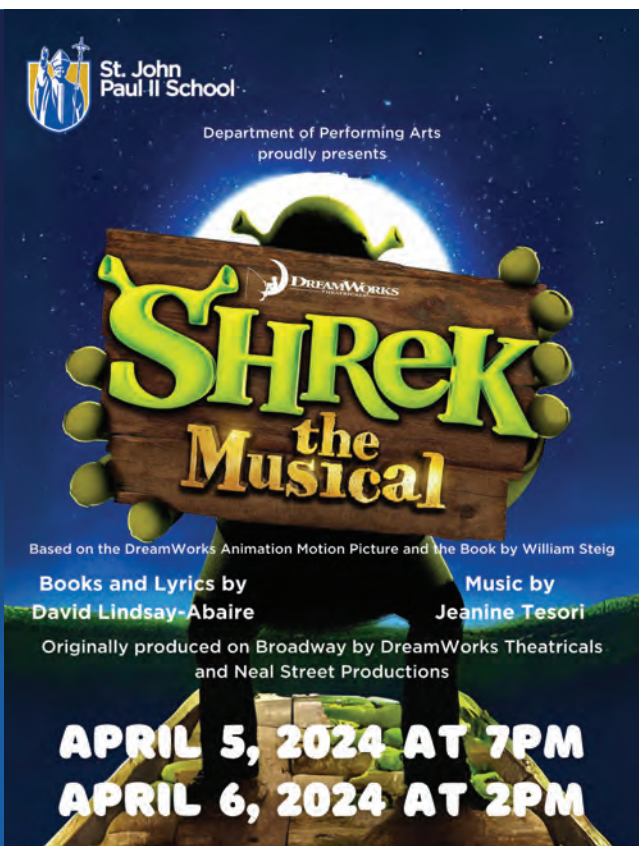
## NO PLACE FOR HATE

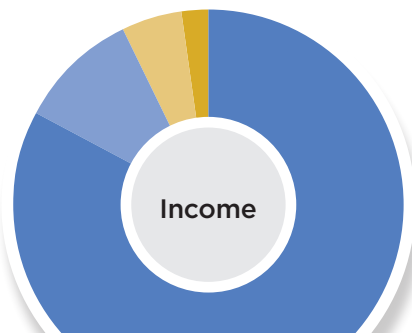

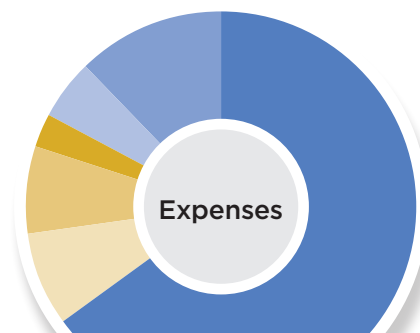
